When Jean married Phil Pionke in 1981, Stephie moved to Berlin where she continued to work for the next 23 years at Berlin Greenhouses and Florists, owned by Phil and Jean. She was a "fixture" at both the greenhouses and the flower shop. She was noted for the 3000 cookies that she baked every year for the flower shop's Christmas Open House.

Stephie was born into the love of Christ at the age of 87 and attended Faith Community Church of Berlin. The Light of Jesus was always seen in her warm smile and eyes, but the true Beauty of my Mom could not only be seen: you felt it in your heart.

Jean, Phil, and Stephie moved to Pagosa Springs, Colorado in 2005, where her love for her Lord and His creation in the beauty of the mountains were enjoyed by her for the last 11 years.

Mom loved Jesus, her family, friends, her dogs Susie and Luna, and all her grand-dogs. She found in God's blessings in her life a reason to be thankful every day.
