Allan John Jackan, 73, of Green Lake, WI, died Saturday, July 1, 2023 at his home.

Al was a very caring, patient and generous man, he truly enjoyed donating his time and skills for many different causes and organizations. He put himself into everything he did and if a job needed doing, he always made sure it got done. He will be greatly missed by everyone.

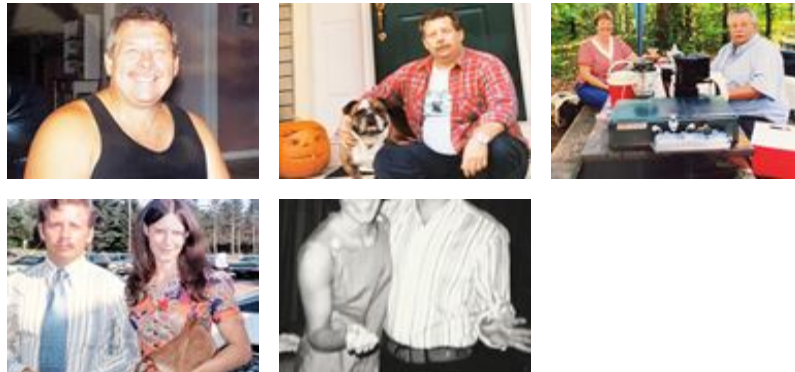
