



Betty J. Sedarski

She was born July 27, 1929, in Winnebago County at home, a daughter of the late Joseph and Rosina Palecek. In 1930 the family moved to Rush Lake, Wisconsin, on the farm.

Betty graduated from Omro High School with the class of 1947.

On June 20, 1951, she married Francis G. Sedarski at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Berlin. They started out living in the City of Berlin until moving out on the homestead on Puchyan Road, Berlin, in 1956.

Betty worked nine years as a schoolteacher. She graduated from Green Lake County Teacher's College and attended the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh.

She drove the Berlin Senior Van for 20 years and worked at Eskimo Comfort for 30 years. She was involved in 4-H for over 35 years and was a member of HCE (formerly Wisconsin Homemakers) for over 50 years. Betty volunteered many hours at the Berlin Food Pantry and Berlin Senior Center. Betty was a faithful member of All Saints Catholic Parish of Berlin, where she served mass for many years. She was a Eucharistic minister and reader at St. Joseph's and All Saints.

She was also a member and held offices in St. Joseph's Altar Society and was a member of CCW at All Saints. Betty attended the Jesuit Retreat House in Oshkosh for over 40 years and inspired many others to attend.

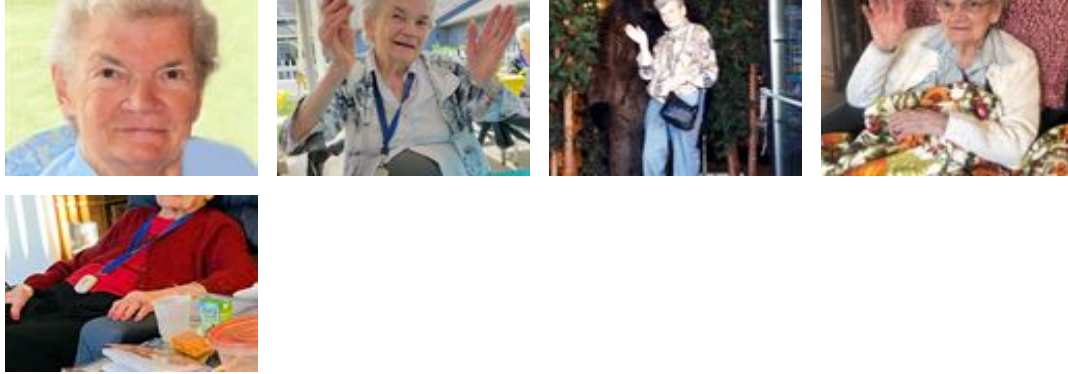
