Carol Joyce Hadel (nee Weeks) passed away peacefully with her family by her side on April 20, 2025 at the age of 81.

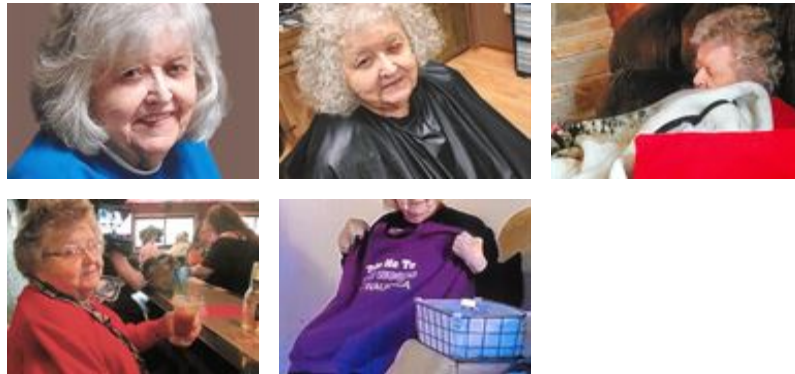
