



## Mr. David C. Braun

October 5, 1939 - December 23, 2015

David C. Braun, age 76, of Wisconsin Rapids, formerly of Berlin, passed away and joined his loving Savior on Wednesday December 24, 2015. He left his life, surrounded by his children and grandchildren, in the Critical Care Unit of Aspirus Riverview Hospital in Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin.

David was born on October 5, 1939, to Clarence and Dorothy (Pigorsch) Braun. He graduated from Concordia High School and attended Concordia College in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He married Kathy Loney on April 16, 1966, and the marriage ended in divorce 37 years later.

He began his long career path as a police officer in Berlin, Wisconsin, but was also a part of the Army National Guard, was employed by the Department of Corrections in Waupun and the Department of Natural Resources in Richland and Green Lake Counties, and then worked as a carpenter in the family business with his father Clarence Braun. Along his life path, he was truly a jack and master of all trades. He enjoyed cooking, hunting, singing, and was an avid fisherman. He loved the Green Bay Packers and never missed a game, either at Lambeau or from the comfort of his living room. David served as alderman for the city of Berlin for many years and was a longtime member of the Berlin Lions Club.

David is survived by his two sisters, Diane (Darrell) Voeltner and Deb (Craig)

Butenhoff, three children, Marcia (Tim) Bruns, Michelle Haydin, and Marshall (Megan) Braun, eight wonderful grandchildren: Raychel, Taylor, Rylie, Ella, Aidan, Renna, Nicholai, and a newborn boy, and many nieces, nephews, great nieces and nephews and other friends and relatives.

He is preceded in death by his parents.

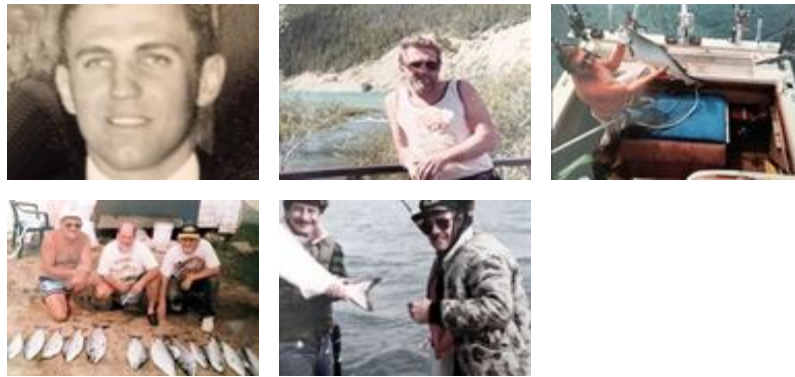
