David Lee Gregor, age 74, of Berlin, died peacefully on Sunday January 3rd 2021 at his home surrounded with the love of his loving family.

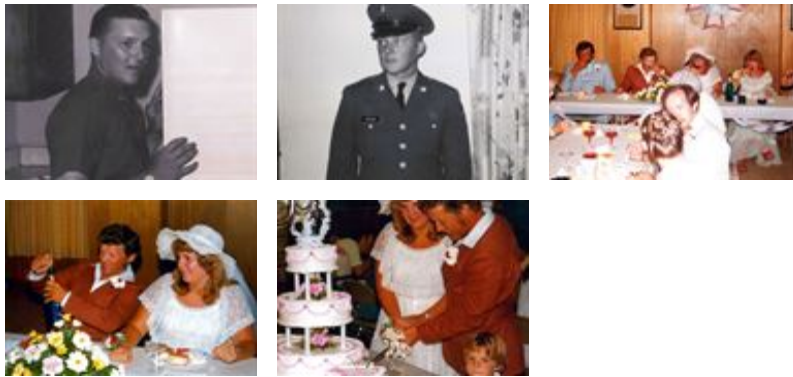
