January 24, 1961 - July 1, 2016

David Anthony Nigbor, age 55, of Berlin, died unexpectedly on Friday evening July 1, 2016.

He was born on January 24, 1961, in Berlin, the son of Charles H (Chuck) Nigbor and Barbara J (Cooley) Nigbor.

David was a construction worker who eventually became a heavy equipment operator for Operating Engineers Union Local 139 in Milwaukee. In 2000 he became permanently disabled due to injuries from a work accident. Then a few years later he was diagnosed with COPD. Dave loved to fish and hunt until his disability. But his biggest love was his motorcycle and riding with his best friend, Buzz Salomon.

Survivors include his wife, Debbie (Zink) Nigbor of Berlin; his mother, Barbara J Nigbor of Berlin; two sisters, Jean (Tim) Riley of Washington DC, Barbie (Chris) Le Duc of Oconomowoc; one brother, Eric (Jodi) Nigbor of Berlin; sister-in-law, Becky Nigbor of Wild Rose; and best friend, Buzz Salomon of Oshkosh. He is further survived by his nieces and nephews, Lauren (Alex) Purnell, Alicia (Doug) Santella, Taylor (fiancée Kendra Stolzheim) Nigbor, Alex Nigbor, Justin Nigbor and Zackary Nigbor; also many aunts, uncles, cousins, and friends.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents; father, Charles (Chuck) Nigbor; and brother, Kenny Nigbor.

In accordance with David's wishes, cremation has taken place and a Celebration of Life luncheon for family and friends will take place on Sunday, July 17, 2016 from noon until 5 pm at the Berlin VFW Hall in Berlin.
