



Mrs. Dolores "Lori" Unangst

March 22, 1929 - May 7, 2014

Doloris L. "Lori" Unangst, age 85, passed away on Wednesday May 7, 2014 at Patriot Place in Berlin, WI.

She was born in Rockford, IL on March 22, 1929, the daughter of Wilbur and Ruby (Fagerstrom) Lund. In 1948 she met Paul Unangst of Rochelle, IL and they went together while Paul attended the University of Illinois. Prior to graduating, Paul was called up for active duty in the US Army so they were married on June 14, 1953. Paul was sent to Washington, DC and, while there, Lori worked for the National Security Agency. After his service they returned to Champagne, IL where Paul completed his degree in Mechanical Engineering and Lori assisted the U of I in the procurement of the famous Carl Sandburg literary collection.

Eventually, the couple settled in Rockford, IL where they started their family. In 1973 the family relocated to the Milwaukee area. Lori kept the books for several small companies and upon retirement volunteered at the Milwaukee Art Museum. Lori was also very active in the local Questers group, a historical study society, eventually serving as President. Lori's favorite hobby was studying and collecting early American furniture and antiques. She loved travelling, especially in England and Scotland where they made several wonderful trips.

Lori is survived by her husband of 61 years; children Kurt (Jan) Unangst of Berlin, WI and Lynn (Phil) Vitale of Rochester, MN; grandchildren Cordan, Keenan and Kale Unangst and Michael and Mathew Vitale; and brother

Donald Lund of Rockford, IL.

She was preceded in death by her parents and siblings Kenneth, Evelyn, Lois and Dorothy.
