On Saturday, May 6, 2023, Donald Bert Eagen loving husband, father, and grandfather passed away peacefully at the age of 91. He passed away on the same land where he was born, the land he tended his whole life, and where he wished to take his last breath. Donald was born on February 18, 1932, in the township of Seneca, Green Lake County, Wisconsin, to Tom and Olga (Kerl) Eagen. He was the youngest of 8 children. He married Mary Ann Rausch on July 20, 1957 in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. They were happily married for 65 years.

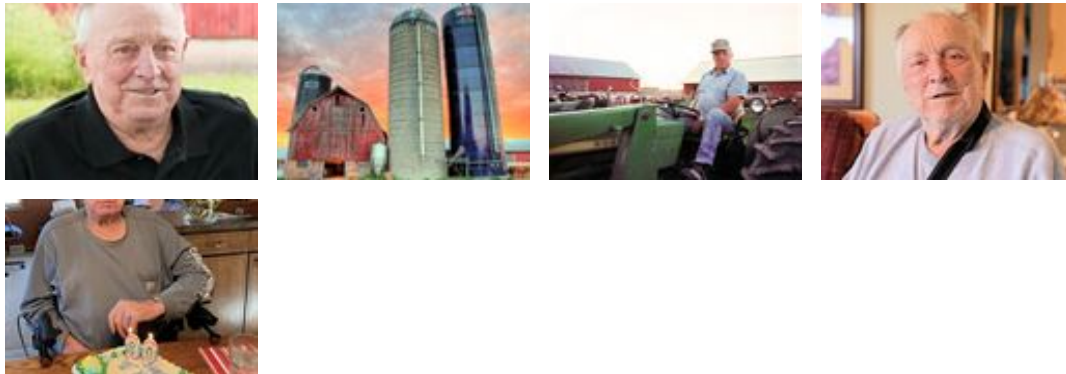
