Doria Jean Disterhaft, age 77, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, March 18 at her home in Berlin, WI.

Doria grew up in Poy Sippi, WI with her brother David and graduated from Berlin High School with the class of 1965.

Doria had many interests and hobbies. She loved communicating with people. Her phone line was frequently busy and her mailbox often full with cards and

letters going to family and friends all over the country. She was an avid reader, but also enjoyed camping, casino trips, bowling, playing cards and going to lots of garage sales and flea markets. Her bird feeders were always well-stocked so she could enjoy watching the wildlife that came to visit. She was a great cook and always made sure there was too much food for everyone to enjoy; especially during the gun deer season at the farm. No one ever went away hungry.

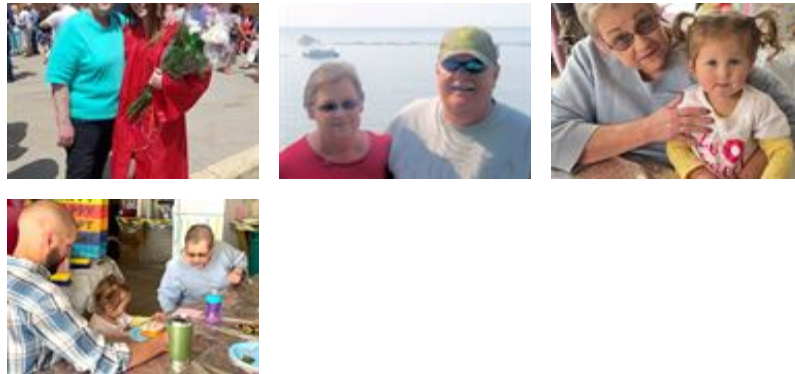

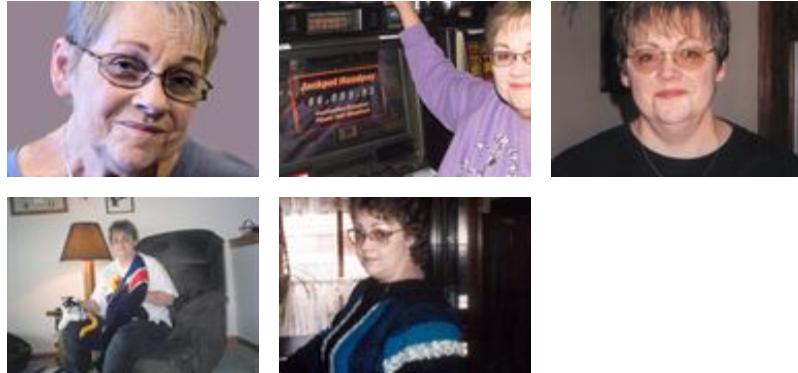
