



## Eric Schroeder

December 8, 1946 - November 30, 2023

Eric C. Schroeder, age 76, passed away on November 30th 2023 at Juliette Manor in Berlin, WI.

Eric was born on December 8th, 1946 in Fond du Lac, WI; the son of Howard and Shirley (Gibson) Schroeder of Berlin.

Eric, a Berlin High School graduate of 1965, was drafted into the army and served in Vietnam from 1966-1968. After returning home, he married his beloved wife Suzanne (Drover) Schroeder and had three boys together. Eric lost Suzanne after complications from diabetes in 1990.

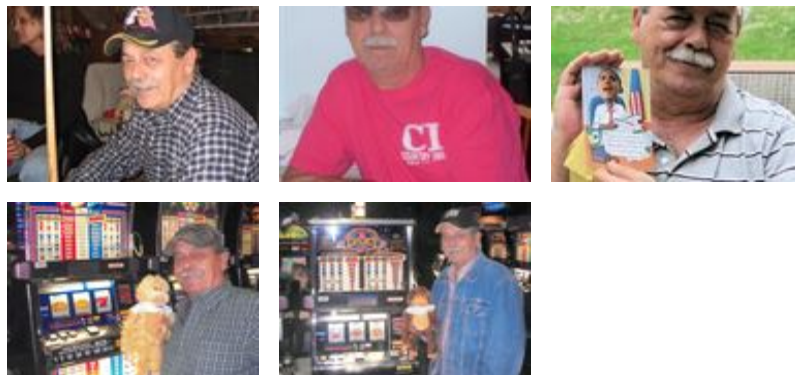
