August 12, 1923 - October 20, 2022

Ethel Steuck, 99, Town of Dakota, rural Wautoma, died on October 20, 2022, at her home with family by her side.

Ethel was born Aug. 12, 1923, in the Town of Leon, Wisconsin, a daughter of Jesse and Florence (Covill) McBair. She graduated from machinist school in Beloit and worked from Chapman's in Berlin from 1943 to 1944.

She was married to Leonard A. Schroeder on April 21, 1941, at Fairburn Church in Redgranite. They were farmers until she went to work at Realist in Berlin where she worked for 26 years until her retirement. Leonard died on Jan. 7, 1979.

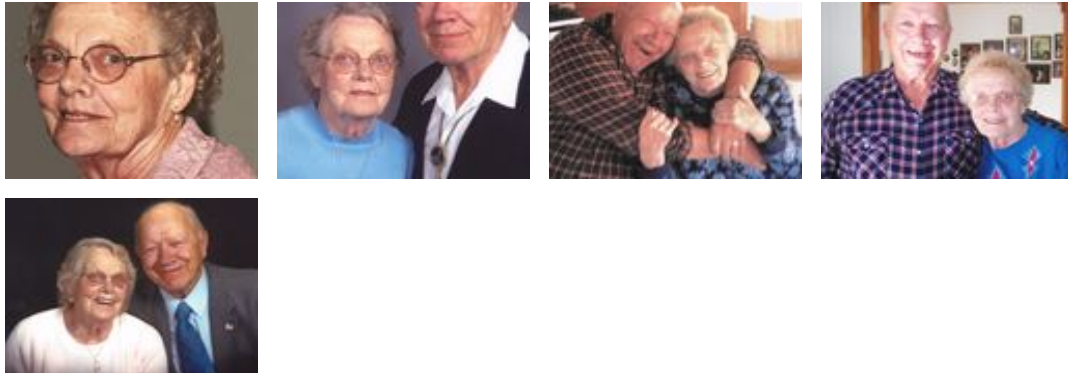
