



## Mr. Gregory "Greg" E. Rodencal

September 30, 1946 - February 17, 2015

Gregory "Greg" E. Rodencal, age 68, of the Town of Aurora, died Tuesday evening, February 17, 2015. He was surrounded by his family, and beloved Mastiff Willow, at the home and surrounding land that he nurtured and loved. Greg was the son of Erwin and Evelyn (Elendt) Rodencal, born on September 30, 1946 on the family farm, in the Town of Rushford, Winnebago county. He was educated in Berlin, graduating from Berlin High School with the Class of 1964. Shortly after graduation, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy, and served during the Vietnam era.
