



Mrs. Helen Domahoski

April 6, 1908 - September 28, 2015

Helen Domahoski, Age 107, of Berlin, passed away peacefully at Patriot Place of Berlin on Monday, September 28, 2015.

Helen was born on April 6, 1908, in Berlin, the oldest girl of 12 children, the daughter of John and Anna (Flesakowski) Gurkowski.

A life-long resident of Berlin, Helen attended Saint Stanislaus Catholic Grade School, when at the time the Nun's only taught in Polish, and at home her parents only spoke in Polish.

Helen married Otto A. Domahoski at St. Stanislaus Catholic Church in Berlin on November 16, 1935, and he preceded her in death on January 10, 1970.

Helen was employed in the Berlin Leather Industry, until the age of 74.

Her favorite childhood activities were roller skating and going to "Ma Fuller's Store" to buy penny candy. Helen was also an expert in needlework, often donating crocheted items to St. Stan's fundraisers.

In 1933, Helen was the second place winner in the Miss Berlin contest and represented Berlin at the Chicago World Fair.

She is a most faithful member of Saint Stanislaus Catholic Parish of Berlin, now All Saints Parish, where she was always involved and is also a member of the Ladies Sodality of the Parish, now C.C.W.

She is survived by a son, Dexter (Jane); a daughter, Judith Rossetti; two grandsons, Mathew Salvadori and Peter Domahoski; three great-grandsons and one great-granddaughter.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Otto, all of her siblings, and one grandson, Seth Rossetti.
