Jeremy's construction degree earned him a position installing Fire and Security systems, of which he was truly proud of. He loved camping with the family and met many lifelong friends at his parents' permanent campsite. He continued to enjoy taking his family out if only for a weekend to enjoy the experience. At a young age he picked up bowling and he continued to enjoy the sport right up to the end. He had recently been instrumental in the restart of the Youth bowling league at Berlin Lanes where he coached and supported youth to learn this lifelong sport. Jeremy was a very active member of the Fox River Wheelers ATV UTV Club and helped MaKayla organize events for the club. One of Jeremy's favorite weekend traditions was getting donuts with the boys and having family dance parties in the living room.
