



## Jo Ellen Weiske

September 2, 1951 - April 13, 2020

Due to the COVID pandemic, Jo Ellen's memorial service was postponed. It now will be held on Saturday, July 17, 2021 with the complete information noted below.

Our beloved sister, Jo Ellen Weiske, went to Jesus on April 13, 2020 at the age of 68. She died at her home in Berlin.

She was born in Berlin, WI, on September 2, 1951, the daughter of Irvin and Betty (Nigbor) Weiske.

Jo Ellen graduated from Berlin High School in 1970 and graduated from UW-Stevens Point with a degree in K-3 Education. She began her teaching career at the Menominee Indian School District in Keshena, WI, and a few years later she joined the Berlin School District, teaching pre-school and kindergarten for many years before retiring in 2012. Teaching was a big part of Jo Ellen's life. She was a wonderful teacher and had great love and compassion for her students and for her colleagues.

Jo Ellen leaves behind her siblings, Carolyn (Leo) Tietz, Dalton; Rita (Chuck) Johanning, Mosinee; Ronald Weiske, Wautoma; Gail (Tony) Torelli, Westerville, OH; and Sandra (John) Resop, Berlin. Jo Ellen was preceded in death by her parents.

Jo Ellen was blessed to be a part of the River Shores Church Family. She

loved reading and memorizing God's Word. She was very caring and generous to so many, but had a special compassion for the elderly and those hurting or in need. Jo Ellen was a true prayer warrior for her family and others and trusted Jesus as her Savior and looked forward to being with Him in eternity. We rejoice in knowing that she is in Heaven. We love you Jo and will miss you but you will always be in our hearts.

The visitation (9–10 a.m.) and memorial service (10 a.m.) for Jo Ellen will be held on Saturday, July 17, 2021, at River Shores Church in Berlin followed by burial at St. Michael's Cemetery. 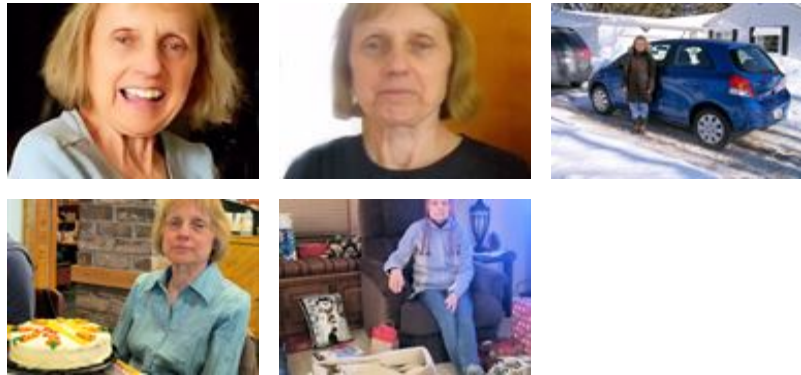
