Judy Wehner, age 65, of Princeton, died peacefully on Saturday, May 28, 2022, after a courageous battle with leukemia.

Judy was born on April 2, 1957 as the third of four children to Milton and Louise Sowatzke in Menomonee Falls, WI. She graduated from Menomonee Falls East High School in 1975.

On March 19, 1976, Judy was united in marriage to Leo Wehner, also a 1975 graduate of Menomonee Falls East High and someone she had known since kindergarten.
