Leonard Anderson (Lenny) passed away peacefully in his sleep on August 1, 2024. Lenny was born on February 23, 1969 in Neenah, Wisconsin to his loving mother Betty Jodarski. When Lenny was six years old, his mother met Edward Anderson. (Eddie) They married and created a new “blended” family. This new family consisted of four older sisters and Lenny. Ed welcomed the new children into the family by adopting them. This meant a lot to Lenny, and he never referred to Eddie as anything other than “Dad”. Times were tough growing up being the only boy, but it made Lenny the caring individual he turned out to be. Lenny had the biggest heart and would help anyone that needed it. In his younger years, Lenny helped his Dad with Ed’s self-started business EA Service Center.

Lenny attended St, Michael’s grade school until eighth grade and then attended Berlin High School where he graduated in 1989. After leaving home, he worked for a plumbing contractor for a few years in Fond Du Lac Wis. He was also employed by Pinnow Sheet Metal installing gutters and Muza Sheet Metal as a machine operator. Lenny’s last 3 years were spent working at Pierce Manufacturing in Appleton.

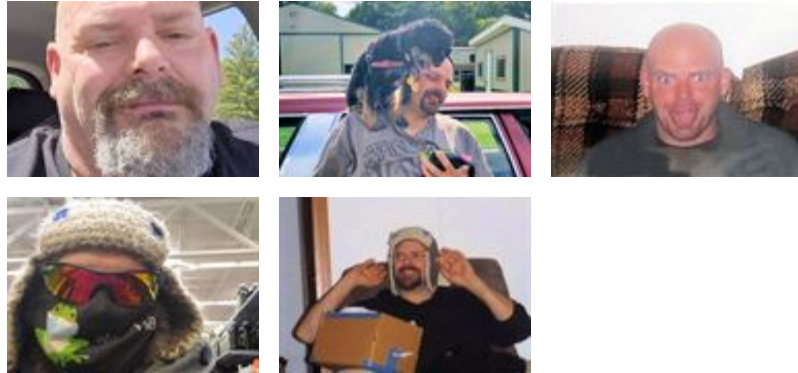
