



Leon Petraszak

November 16, 1937 - June 11, 2024

Leon Andrew Petraszak, 86, a life-long Berlin community member and business owner, died peacefully at ThedaCare Appleton Medical Center on Tuesday, June 11, 2024, surrounded by family, after a 10-year struggle with Alzheimer's Disease and other health issues.

Leon was born on November 16, 1937 to Gertrude (Disterhaft) and Andrew Petraszak. He proudly graduated from Berlin High School in 1955 and shared fond memories of playing football with friends.

His football team was inducted into the BHS Athletic Hall of Fame in 2018 and was a life-long supporter of the BHS Alumni Association.

He married his beautiful bride, Elaine (Bradley) Petraszak on June 22, 1956 at St. Michael's Church in

Berlin. Leon & Elaine did live in Madison and Appleton for a short period of time, but returned to Leon's

beloved Big Island Road in the Town of Seneca and resided at the Petraszak Homestead for the last 26

years. Leon had no grass growing under his feet as he was always busy working, from his early career as

a union excavating operator for Central Contracting and then as a self-employed business owner of

Petraszak & Sons Excavating. Leon never claimed to be perfect and often pondered in later years whether or not he did "life" right and sought comfort at weekly mass, even on the Sunday before he passed away, making sure to inform the altar kids that he too was an altar boy many years ago. He belonged to the Catholic Knights of Columbus and cherished socializing with many other community members.

During their 2 weeks short of 67 years of marriage, Leon and Elaine raised 7 successful children, who all value the importance of family and hard work.

Leon enjoyed many years of working, camping, traveling to many US states and other countries, spending winters in Florida for 20 years, hunting all sorts of wildlife, fishing, woodworking, working on his family genealogy and spending time with family and friends at social events, holidays and family reunions.

He was preceded in death by his parents; parents-in-law (Clara [Klotzbuecher] Bradley); his 4 brothers-in-law (Mike Eggleston, Brian Flanagan, Gary Freund & Sam Bradley); 2 sisters-in-law (Marilyn Bradley Freund and Sharon Roberts Bradley).

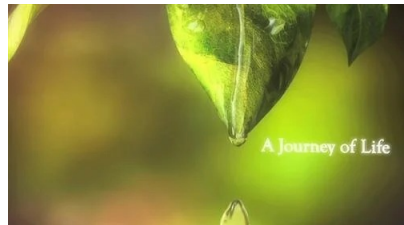

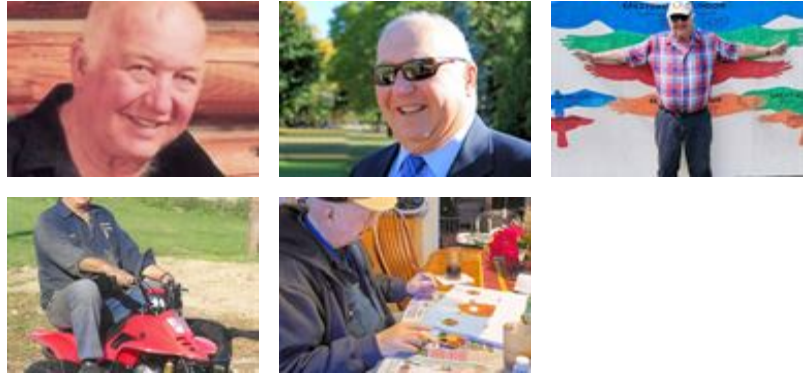
