



Mr. Leonard P. Reetz

March 23, 1926 - January 5, 2015

Leonard P. Reetz, age 88, of Berlin, WI, passed away unexpectedly on Monday, January 5th, 2015 at the Berlin Memorial Hospital.

He was born on March 23rd, 1926 in Green Lake County, the Son of Frank and Hulda Hunt (Reetz). He served in the U.S. Army, Military of the 45th Division, 700th Ordnance Military Specialty branch in the Korean War from 09/25/1950 – 09/08/1952.

On April 14th, 1953, he was united in marriage to Lucille Chappa at St. Mark's Catholic Church in Redgranite, WI. He dedicated his life to family, the Catholic Faith and farming on the Reetz family farm in the Town of Seneca, until he retired in 1992. Leonard enjoyed working with his hands crafting wood projects, watching for and hunting deer and squirrels, and taking care of his wild bird friends.
