Our family has learned so many precious old fashioned values from Lucille. She was truly one of a kind and one who cherished her catholic faith.

Lucille loved her grandchildren and was always so proud of them. She loved to hear about Rodney's job and his day to day activities including his dog Holly. She enjoyed the shopping and errand trips with Tammy who always made sure grandma got to her appointments on time, and always had fun picking Badger 5 lottery numbers for Tammy.

She loved Patriot Place and all of the people and staff. She enjoyed getting her nails done, going to church in the chapel, visits from Father David and looked forward to the therapy dogs from Sassu Enterprises which came there once a month.

Lucille is survived by her son, Clarence (Susan) Hopp; grandson, Rodney Hopp; granddaughter, Tammy (Tom) Midona; brother, Clarence Kozlowski; godchild, Jean Zabel; several nieces, nephews and other relatives and many friends.
