Marie Treder, 99, of Berlin passed away from this earth on Monday, February 6, 2017 at Patriot Place in Berlin, Wisconsin where she had resided for 7 years. She was educated at Berlin Catholic Schools, Berlin High, and Green Lake County Normal where she graduated and became a certified school teacher.

Marie and Ralph were married June 21, 1938, until his death on July 10, 1983. She was a devoted wife and beloved mother who raised 8 children, as well as a 4-H Club leader, choir member at church, and performed for charities and local events as Sister Amnesia of the Sisters Act. After Ralph died, Marie was employed as an in-home CNA caregiver.

All of Marie's children survive her: Alfred (Mary), Michael (Anna, deceased), Ralph (Suzanne), Mary (John Berge), Paul (Frances), Jude (Nick Wolff), Gloria (Jeff Miller), and Tom (Tracy Harrington). She is also survived by 19 grandchildren and 22 great-grandchildren.

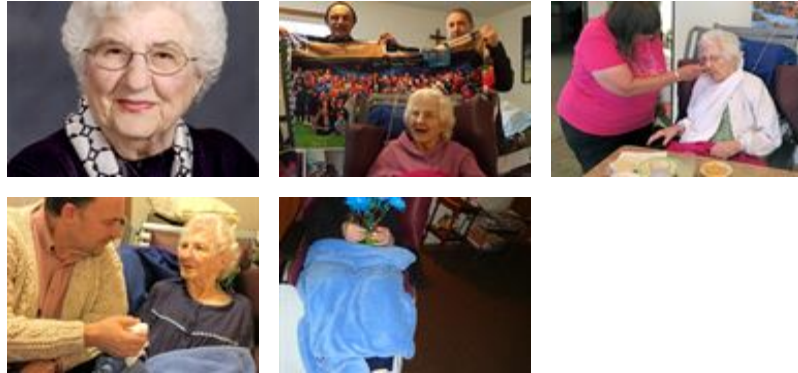
