



## Marion Kuharski

June 12, 1932 - November 1, 2025

Marion A Kuharski age 93 of Rush Lake, WI, went to be with her Lord and Savior on November 1, 2025. She passed away peacefully with her family at her side at Theda Care hospital in Berlin, WI.

She was born on June 12, 1932 at home in Fond du lac county to Albert and Lillian (Henke) Nemitz. She was baptized on June 24, 1932 and confirmed on Pentecost Sunday on June 9, 1946 at St Johns Church in Nekimi.

She was married to Sidney Kuharski on May 12, 1956 at First English Lutheran Church in Oshkosh by Rev. E.A. Koch. They lived on a dairy farm in Rush Lake where they started their family, she lived there until March of this year when she went to assisted living at Brown Wilcox in Berlin. She helped on the farm, raised 2 children and started working at Rippin Good Cookies, where she worked for 38 years until she retired in 1998. Then she went to work at EAA in the volunteer kitchen for 10 years while there she met a lot of interesting people from all over the United States and Canada.

After retiring from there she would help with catering, gardening and whatever she was able to help with. During the winter months she would fly south to Ruskin Florida where she had a house and would invite friends down for the winter.

She was a very sociable person who loved to go and do things with her friends and go to polka dances on Sunday afternoons. She was also very active in 4-H and the Winnebago fair where she would work with the

Cloverbuds. She had been an active leader for Lakeshore 4-H club for 51 years.

Her last months at Brown Wilcox you would see her working on puzzles, she would get them done and they would frame them and hang them up there. She enjoyed giving the staff a hard time but they enjoyed her dearly there. She is survived by her children Dennis Kuharski of Tampa Florida, and Kathy (George) Wunrow

of Rush Lake. 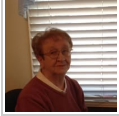
