December 19, 1933 - September 5, 2022

Norene F. Seaman, age 88, of Green Lake died on September 5, 2022, at ThedaCare Medical Center in Berlin WI.

She was born December 19, 1933, in Berlin, the daughter of Norbert and Irene (Umbreit) Bartol. On February 15, 1958, she was united in marriage to James Seaman in Berlin.
