Norman Arthur Becker, 86 was called to his heavenly home on October 7, 2025 following a brief stay at Juliette Manor in Berlin

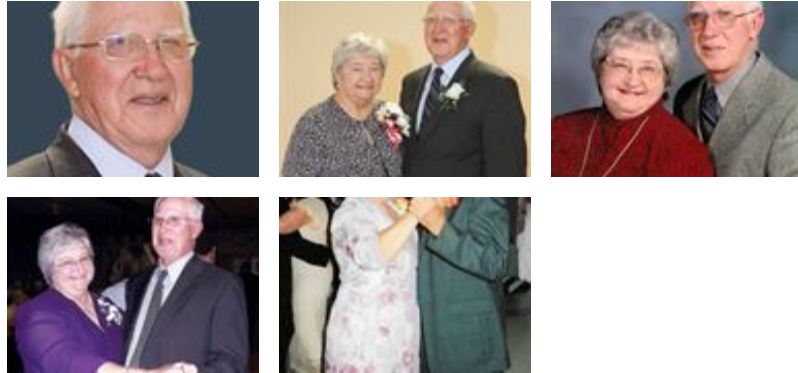
