One of his proudest moments was in 2012 when Victoria won Grand Champion sheep at the county fair.

At an early age Pat enjoyed going with his father to deliver seed and fertilizer

to the local farmers. Continuing with his passion for farming he hauled milk for Neubauer's and then went on to be a trucker for Brian Retzlaff Trucking. Most recently, he worked as a crop adjuster for Zurich (RCIS). He excelled in talking "farmer" to farmer". The people he worked with became like family to him. Farming kept him busy, but he found time for hunting with his buddies and really enjoyed the hunting trips out west.

Pat was a member of the Seneca 4H, Coon Hunters Association, Green Lake County 4-H Leaders Association, Lifelong volunteer for the Green Lake County Fair, Green Lake County Drainage Board, and Waukau Flying Mane Riding Club for over 13 years.

He was the type of guy that you could always depend on, lending a hand wherever needed and always willing to help others. His presence at the Fair and the Flying Mane Riding Club will be greatly missed by many.

He is survived by his wife, Amy; daughter, Victoria (Mason); sisters, Margaret (Troy) Gurno and their son Cole, Elizabeth Swiecichowski and her sons Patrick and Michael; special "cousin" Joe Stemler II; other relatives and many friends.

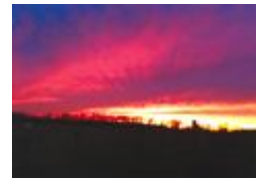
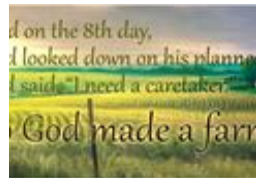
