September 27, 1922 - September 6, 2020

Ruth Krause of Berlin passed away September 6th, 2020 at Patriot Place Berlin.

Ruth was born September 27, 1922 on a farm in Waushara County to Margaret (Hoppa) Lloyd and Louis Lloyd. She attended first grade at Washington School in Berlin as her Father had a farm implement dealership in Berlin. The family then moved back to the farm and she attended Clark School on Cypress Avenue which was later moved to Riverside Park in Berlin. Ruth graduated from Berlin High School in 1940 with a class of 47 students. After graduation she attended Green Lake County Normal for two years and received her teaching degree. She started her teaching career teaching in rural schools in Fond du Lac County and lived with a family in the school district. She then taught in rural schools in Winnebago County. At that time teachers were more than just a teacher, they were a janitor as well. Next she taught at Waukau State Grade School then returned to Berlin and taught fourth grade in the Berlin School System for 26 years.

During her early years she continued her education and received a Bachelor Degree at Oshkosh Technical College and received enough credits to get her Masters but did not write the test to get the Degree. Ruth retired in 1985 after teaching for 43 years.

Ruth was a volunteer at the Berlin Senior Citizen Center, the Berlin Hospital Auxillary and was a member of St. Joseph's Altar Society.

Ruth married Fred Krause of rural Omro September 17, 1949 and lived on the

farm with Fred's parents, August and Anna Krause. They built a new home on the farm in 1960 and Fred continued to work the farm while working full time at Speed Queen in Omro. Fred passed away September 17, 1995.

Ruth was preceded in death by her husband Fred, her parents Louis and Margaret Lloyd, sisters Genevieve (Clarence) Pribnow, Lois (Henry) Gunther, Florence (Clarence) Stickney and Orpha (Carl) Piekarski. She was also preceded in death by her infant brother George and her brother Pat (Pauline) Lloyd.

She is survived by many nieces, nephews and other relatives and friends.

In lieu of flowers monetary donations should be made to a scholarship fund for someone going into elementary education or to All Saints Congregation Building Fund.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Tuesday, September 15, 2020 at 10:30 a.m. at All Saints Catholic Parish, Berlin, with Father David Greenfield officiating.

Family and friends may visit with the family and pay their respects to Ruth on Monday, September 14, 2020 from 4:00-7:00 p.m. with a rosary to be recited at 6:45 p.m. and also on Tuesday September 15, 2020 from 9:00-10:00 a.m. at the Wiecki-Skipchak Funeral Home in Berlin.

Burial will follow services at the Eureka Cemetery.
