Shirley Mae (Hunt) Schramer, of Berlin, passed away on January 11, 2021 at her residence at Berlin Senior Village surrounded with the love of her family. She was born on December 7, 1925, in Batavia Illinois, the daughter of Georgina Huxley Lewis Hunt and Alfred Edward Hunt. She survived her nine siblings.

She married Richard John Schramer on October 10, 1942 in Illinois. During WWII she lived with her mother and father-in-law in West Chicago, Illinois while Richard was overseas. Shirley loved to play the piano, organ, and sing. When she was a child her entire Hunt family sang and danced on stage. She loved music and was a member of All Saints Catholic Church in Berlin. She worked at the Senior Center for over 10 years where she made many friends and enjoyed playing cards. Shirley loved nature photography and entered several of her photos at the Green Lake Fair winning some blue ribbons.

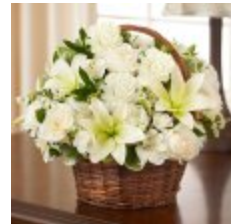
