Stephanie Dahl, age 50, left this world to be with her Savior on Friday, September 8, 2017 in San Diego, California. She was undergoing yet another surgery in her battle with her MEN-1 genetic disease when her loving Lord called her home. Stephanie was born on December 29, 1966 in Berlin Wisconsin during a blinding snow storm.

There will be a celebration of her life at St. John's Lutheran Church in Berlin, Wisconsin, where she was baptized and confirmed, at 11:00 AM on Saturday, September 16, 2017. She will also be remembered at a memorial service at her home church, St. Paul's Lutheran Church in San Diego, California. Visitation will be at Skipchak Funeral Home in Berlin on Friday, September 15, 2017 from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

She had been living in the San Diego area since graduating from the University of Wisconsin, Oshkosh in 1990. Her early school years were spent at St. John's Lutheran School in Berlin and Berlin High School.
