Susan Joan La Buda, age 52, of Oshkosh, formerly of Berlin, died peacefully on Thursday morning March 22, 2018 at the Aurora Hospital under Hospice care of Oshkosh with her family beside her.

She was born on February 27, 1966 in Berlin, the daughter of Frank and Margaret (Ragenoski) La Buda.

She was a 1984 graduate of the Berlin High School and then attended MPTC in Fond du Lac studying to be an administrative assistant secretary.

A Memorial has been established in her memory.

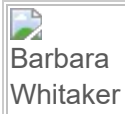
