



Thomas "Tom" Duerr

March 28, 1932 - August 9, 2021

On Monday August 9th, 2021 Thomas Roger Duerr, "The Last of the Wild Ones", passed away peacefully with his daughter De Anna by his side, after a short battle with cancer.

Tom was born March 28th, 1932 to Charles and Hazel (Johnson) Duerr in Utley, Wisconsin. He was the 5th of 11 children. Tom had a difficult childhood. At the age of 10, he and his siblings were placed into foster homes. In his teens, Ovila and Hunts Ringhand opened their home to him and became his family.

Tom served in the United States Army from November 30th, 1950 until May 14th, 1954. He was stationed in Korea for 18 months with the Infantry 24th Division. He received several accommodations for his service. In May of 2014, Tom was able to join the Honor Flight to the Korean War Memorial in Washington D.C.

On March 10th, 1956, he was united in marriage to Beatrice Spielvogel. Together they had five daughters. Tom made a career of being a long-haul truck driver. In retirement he drove school bus. Tom enjoyed deer hunting and spending time on the Thom farm. Almost every Sunday was spent gathering with his children and grandchildren for dinner and lots of laughs.

He was a social butterfly. He was known and loved by every bar and bartender. One of his favorite places to be was Jorgies in Borth for sign-in. He is survived by his daughters, Dawn (Chris) Bludau, De Anna Lueptow, Laurie Duerr, and Brenda (James) Dittmer, daughter of the heart Tammi Gaab,

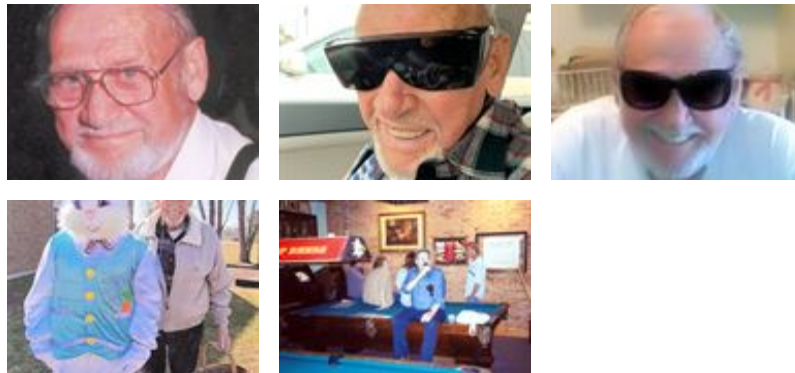
