Thomas (Tom) "Bozo" Resop, age 83, of Lohrville and Redgranite, formerly lifetime resident of Berlin, passed away peacefully on Saturday evening June 11, 2016 at the Mercy Medical Center of Oshkosh.

Tom was born on June 7, 1933 in Berlin the son of Ezadore and Wanda (Bozych) Resop.
