



## Mr. Timothy Fink

September 1, 1960 - October 9, 2014

Timothy (Tim) R. Fink, age 54, of Fremont, formerly of Berlin, passed away peacefully on Thursday morning October 9, 2014 at the Weyauwega Health Care Center.

Tim lived in Berlin from 1971 to 1987 and then Fremont from 2005 to 2012 and then his health failed and in Nursing Home care from 2013 to present.

Tim was born on September 1, 1960 in Ripon the son of Harold Robert and Lorraine Margaret (Strebe) Fink.

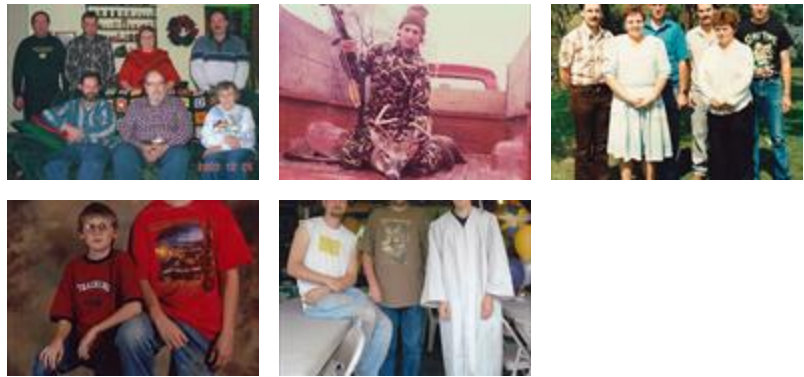
